Residents of Preston have the opportunity to have their say on the future of our parish from 2017 to 2031. As you are important members of our small community we are keen to know your views. We will be very grateful if you would fill this questionnaire in. If there are any questions you don't want to answer, please, don't feel you have to!

We hope by now that you have heard of the decision to produce a Neighbourhood Plan for Preston Parish. This was made at a Village Meeting on 26th June 2016. The Neighbourhood Plan is being drawn up by a Steering Group of five residents appointed by the Parish Council.

A Neighbourhood Plan sets out how we want our parish to evolve. Once the Plan is made and agreed, it becomes law up until 2031.

- What new facilities would you like to see in Preston?
- Do you appreciate the 'open green spaces' in this country parish?
- What would make your life in this parish better and/or more enjoyable for you?

A separate survey has been sent to the adults of the parish. Some of them may have grown up here. They may remember what it was like when they were 'Young Residents'. But ONLY YOU can tell us what it is like NOW, for a Young Resident.

Please remember, in this special Questionnaire, there are no right or wrong answers. We just need to know what YOU think. Everything you write will be treated in confidence. The questionnaire will be read and analysed by our professional analysis team who are not from Preston. Others of you may feel that some of the wording is a little condescending (including the last sentence...) Our sincere apologies if either applies to you.
